**Phil 2:5-11**

**Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,** 6 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 **but emptied Himself**, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. 8 Being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself** by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9 For this reason also, **God highly exalted Him**, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

- I. Healthy Christians submit to attitude **inspections**. (v.5)

1. Am I demonstrating a **unifying** attitude?
2. Am I demonstrating a **sacrificial** attitude?
3. Am I demonstrating a **prayerful** attitude?
4. Am I demonstrating a **joyful** attitude?

- II. Healthy Christians submit to attitude **adjustments**. (v.6-7)

Although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 **but emptied Himself**, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.

1. Christ **surrendered** all.

Emptied Himself...

2. Christ **served** all.

Took the form of a bond-servant...

3. Christ **sympathized** with all.

Was made in the likeness of men...

- III. Healthy Christians submit to attitude **implementation**. (v.8)

1. Attitude implementation requires that we **man up.**

Being found in **appearance as a man,**

2. Attitude implementation requires that we **wise up**

3. Attitude implementation requires that we **check up.**
