

I Will Avoid Churchianity and Choose Love!

1 Corinthians 13:1-3

If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. And if I give all my possessions to feed the poor, and if I surrender my body to be burned, but do not have love, it profits me nothing.

Churchianity:

Practicing our church and religious beliefs according to human standards rather than biblical guidelines

1. Love makes our words pleasing to God. (v.1)

If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become ***a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.***

2. Love makes our worship pleasing to God. (v.2)

If I have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, ***I am nothing.***

3. Love makes our works pleasing to God. (v.3)

And ***if*** I give all my possessions to feed the poor, and if I surrender my body to be burned, but do not have love, ***it profits me nothing.***
